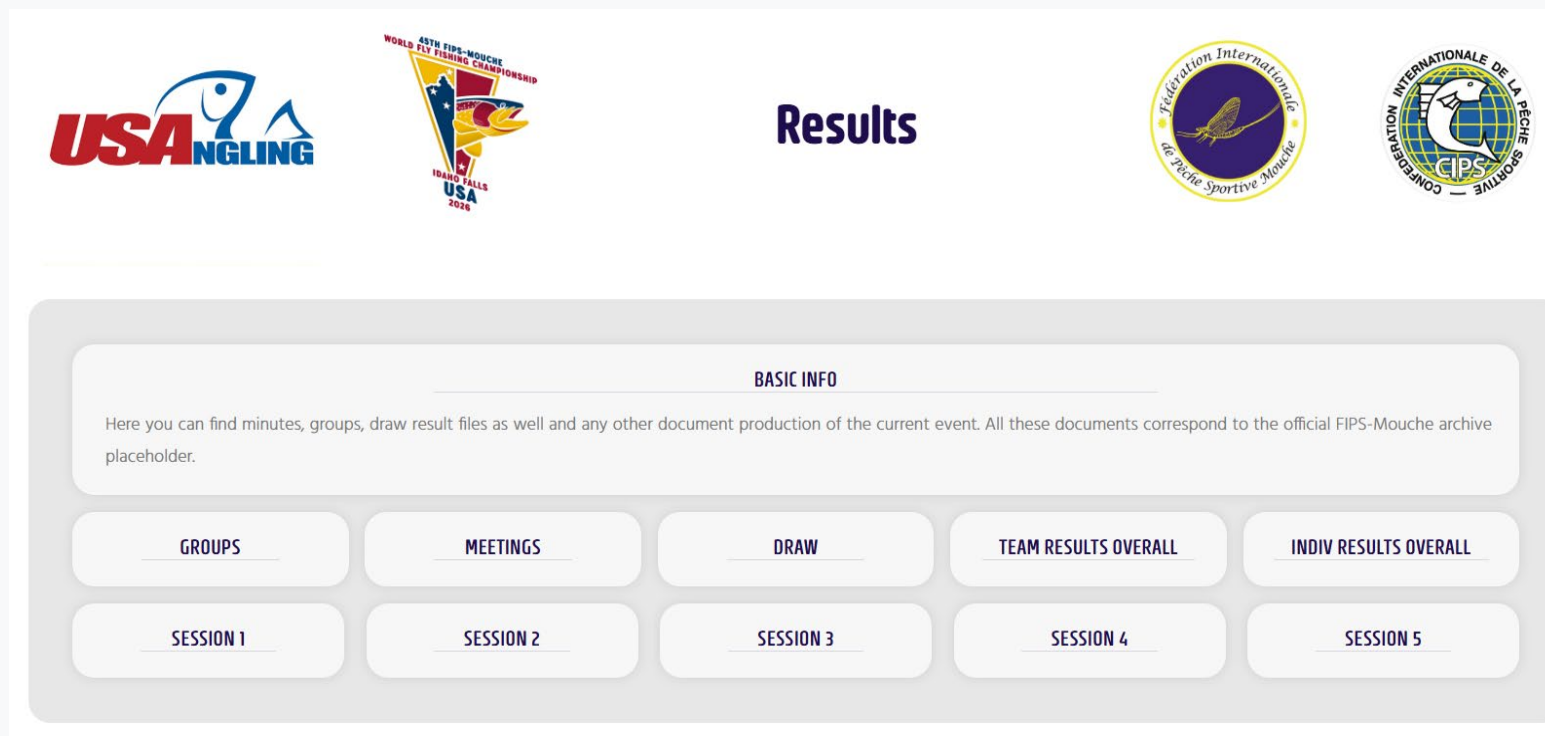

## 4. Draw

- Proces
- Each captain will come forward to make the physical draw for him team
  - Step 1 : verify that names are correct
  - Step 2 : identify reserve (if any)
  - Step 3 : draw of the team number
  - Step 4 : draw group for each team member
- At end of draw the groups table will be made available

## 5. Safety — Fauna & Flora

### WILDLIFE

#### Bears

Stay alert, make noise, never approach  
We do not expect to see any as they avoid people and large groups especially.

#### Moose

Give wide berth — can be aggressive  
Bad sight and they will move out once we move in

#### Rattlesnakes

Watch footing, especially rocky areas  
Do not expect to see them along river, just on rocky trail areas  
None seen last two times preparing beats

#### Bugs (ticks, spiders)

Use repellent. Check thoroughly after sessions

#### Poison Ivy

Leaves of three, let it be



#### Hawthorne

Thorny bushes — watch footing



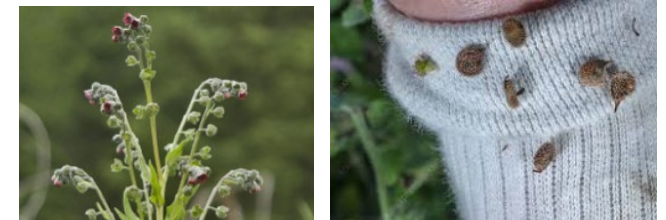
#### Stinging Nettle

Avoid contact with bare skin



#### Houndstongue

Sticktights — check clothing



## 5. Safety — Emergency Plan

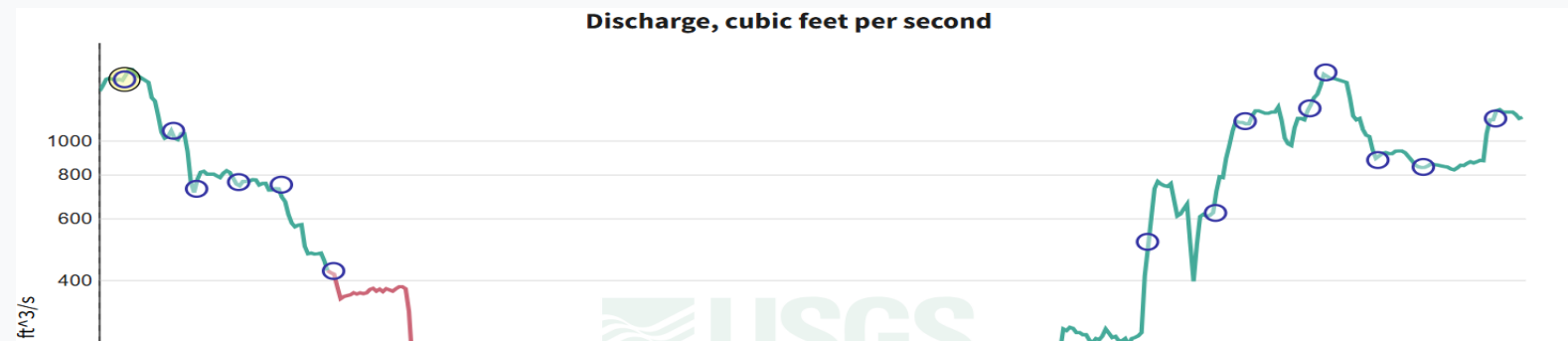
Sector I — Henry's Fork

Sector III — Teton

Sector IV — Sheridan Lake

Sector V — Grey's River

- All Sector Judges have first aid kits
- All Controllers have hand radios for communication with Sector Judge (safety & rules)
- All Sector Judges have high-performance radios + satellite communication for emergency services
- “Overwatch” communications and safety search and rescue contact for Henry's Fork and Teton
- Henry’s Fork is unusually high, due to drought conditions this year water is being diverted  
Roughly Same flow as Ladies and Youth championship last year



# 5. River Overview — Safety / Good Practices

## Sector I — Henry's Fork

- Can be a Steep hike down.
- If you are concerned, use Trekking Pole
- Strong recommendation not to have fully assembled rods, (Rod Socks, or Rod Protector)
- Some have hiked in with hiking boots and change into waders on the river
- Wading may be challenging. We have some controllers with river safety ropes.
- Toilets available at parking area (Bear Gulch) or at top of slide.  
Forest service asks us not to use public one

## Sector III — Teton

- May have a long hike up to 5 km, but easy.
- Just be aware of Rattlesnakes, not expected, but possible
- River wading will be easy
- Toilets available at Van drop off

## Sector V — Grey's River

- Easy access to all beats from road
- River wading will be easy
- Toilets at campgrounds, not easily accessible from beats

### SAFETY

#### Lightning protocol

Sector Judge Warns controllers (lightning within ~30 sec ≈ 6 miles)

Sector Judge stops fishing for all (lightning within 15 sec ≈ 3 miles)

Fishing pause of ten minutes, until 30 seconds between flash and bang. Max cumulative wait: 1 hour maximum allowable.

Session may end as late as 14:00 if delayed

## 5. Lake Overview — Safety / Good Practices

### Sector II — Hebgen Lake

- Big water, wind can be an issue
- Must wear PFD during session  
PFD available on boat, but you may not like it

### Sector IV — Sheridan Lake

- Must wear PFD during session  
PFD available on boat, but you may not like it

Sector 4 — Sheridan Lake

### SAFETY

#### Lightning protocol

Sector Judge Warns controllers (lightning within ~60 sec ≈ 12 miles)

Sector Judge stops fishing for all (lightning within 30 sec ≈ 6 miles)

Fishing pause of ten minutes, until 30 seconds between flash and bang. Max cumulative wait: 1 hour maximum allowable.

Session may end as late as 14:00 if delayed

# Rules and Rules Modifications

## Controller Positioning

Controllers cannot cross river to control — must stay on same side as access, except where specifically noted (Teton and Grey's Specific beat variances)

## Hebgen Lake Flies

2 flies only on Hebgen Lake (Montana State Law).

## Difficult Banks

Controllers may step into river to ease measuring of fish — cannot wade out.

## Hook Removal

As defined in RM, angler will remove hook once verified fairly caught (fish welfare). Complete text in RM on championship website.

## Drogues

Can be used and deployed on either side of boat per instruction of angler in control.

## Netting Warning

Single warning noted in comments for improper netting or fish in water.

## Fish Measuring

Preference to measure in net over/on top of tray. Small fish near 20 cm measured in tray. Angler may request tray measurement on any fish for accuracy.

# River Specific Notes and Beat Markings

- All rivers are public access. In these States, all water is owned by the state/public. We cannot close waters to fishing to others
- All Beats have Top and Bottom Marker
- Where possible and needed a flag on the opposite side of river
- On Teton there will be Multiple River crossings. All will be marked for crossing and you must stay inside the boundary of the crossing area as defined. These crossings are open for transit during sessions.  
Except for between large buffer between Beats 8 and 9 all crossings are connected to beats on all 4 corners. You will see an Top and Bottom beat marker on opposite river sides. Flags or Poles to indicate corners.  
Do not leave the crossing buffers  
All are less than waist deep, most knee deep



# Breakfast, Hotels and Bus/Van Departures

- Please note that Breakfast areas are somewhat limited at Hotels  
Particularly the Best Western.  
Opens at 5:30, but they suggest that you do some staggering of teams/anglers to avoid all persons in a huge rush right at the start. They are bringing in extra staff, but Monday may be a bit of a learning curve. **Rivers 05:30 , Lakes 06:15**
- Hotels have a reminder about Fly tying materials and damage as well as room services. You are required to have a credit card on file to cover damages if any.
- All Transportation vehicles will be marked with daily group identification
- Bus for Henrys Fork, Hebgen, and Sheridan  
No limit to Captains, Managers, Others
- Vans for Teton River and Grey's River  
Vans will be loaded by Beat Grouping for example beats 1-5  
May have limit on Captain and Managers traveling along  
Will assess and adjust Tuesday if it is an issue

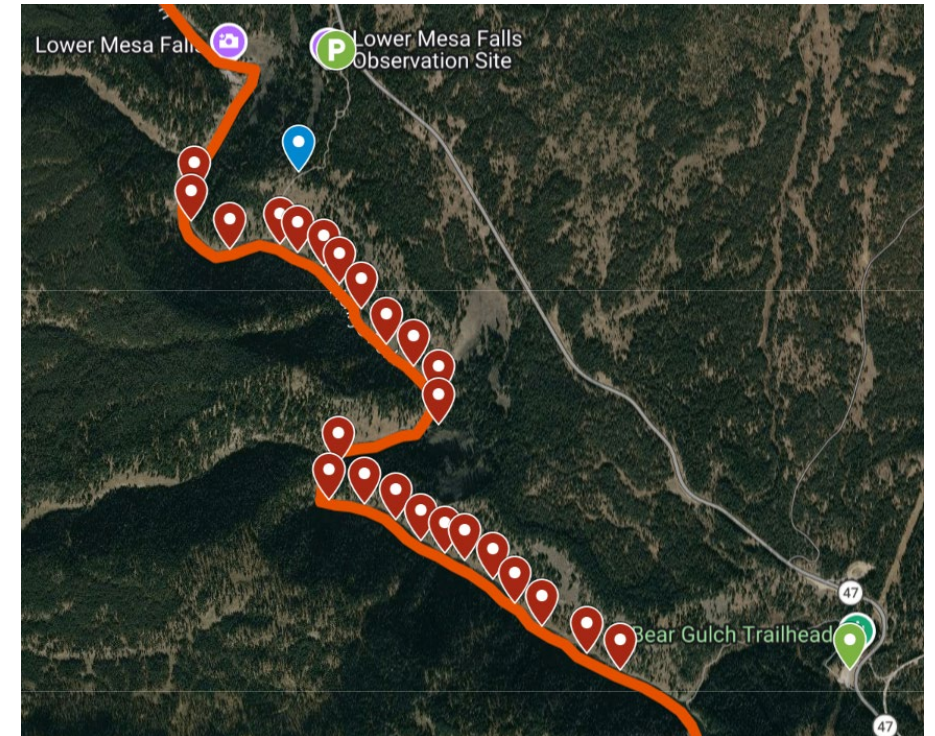

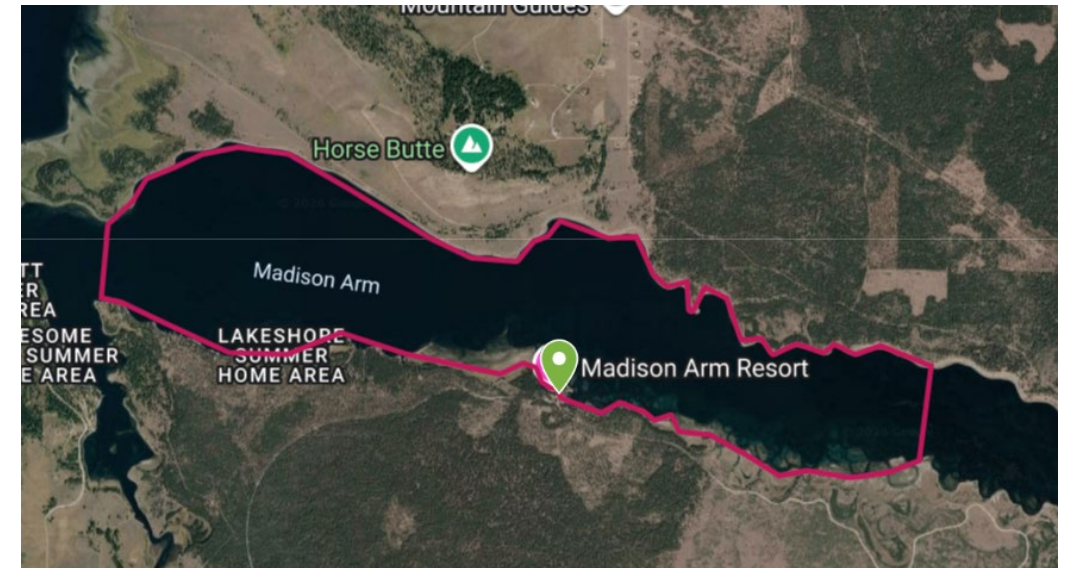

- Variety of motor boats 14'-19' range and engine sizes, but all will be speed limited based on slowest boat. Will change daily, due to volunteer changes.
- Drogues provided for all boats
- Most are tiller controlled boats, a couple may be center console.
- Toilets at Madison Arm Resort
- Draw opened at lake

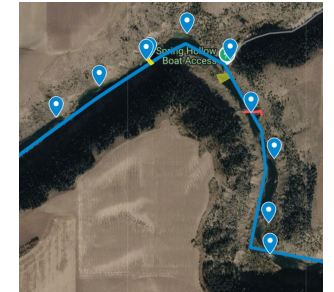

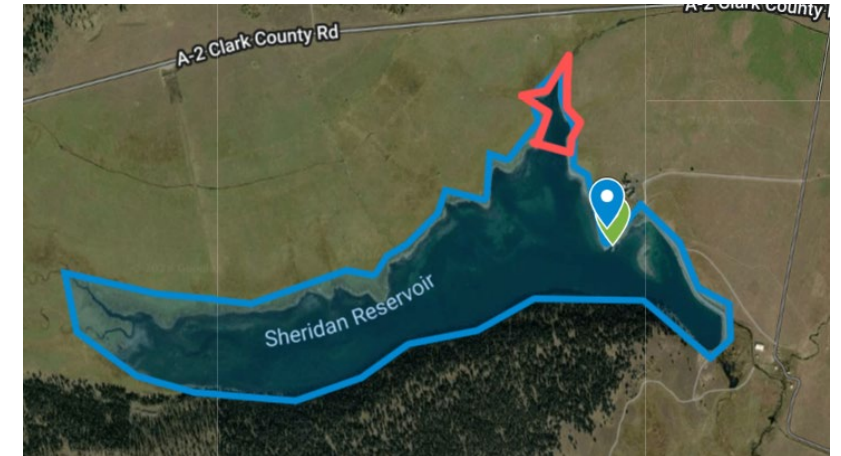

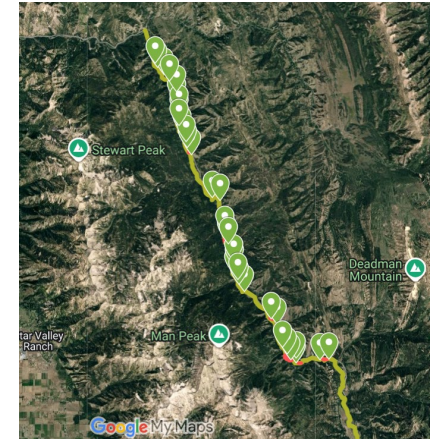

## Captains on River

Captains must identify themselves and show armband to controllers on river sectors.

## Gear Help

Help moving gear to/from beats or boats is acceptable before and after sessions. No assistance from team or controllers during session.

## Photos

Controllers may take photos for championship media sharing — not to be shared with other anglers during competition.  
We have media who will be working to capture a photo of every angler.

## Licenses

Daily verification of licenses. Supervisors / judges will check upon boarding transport.

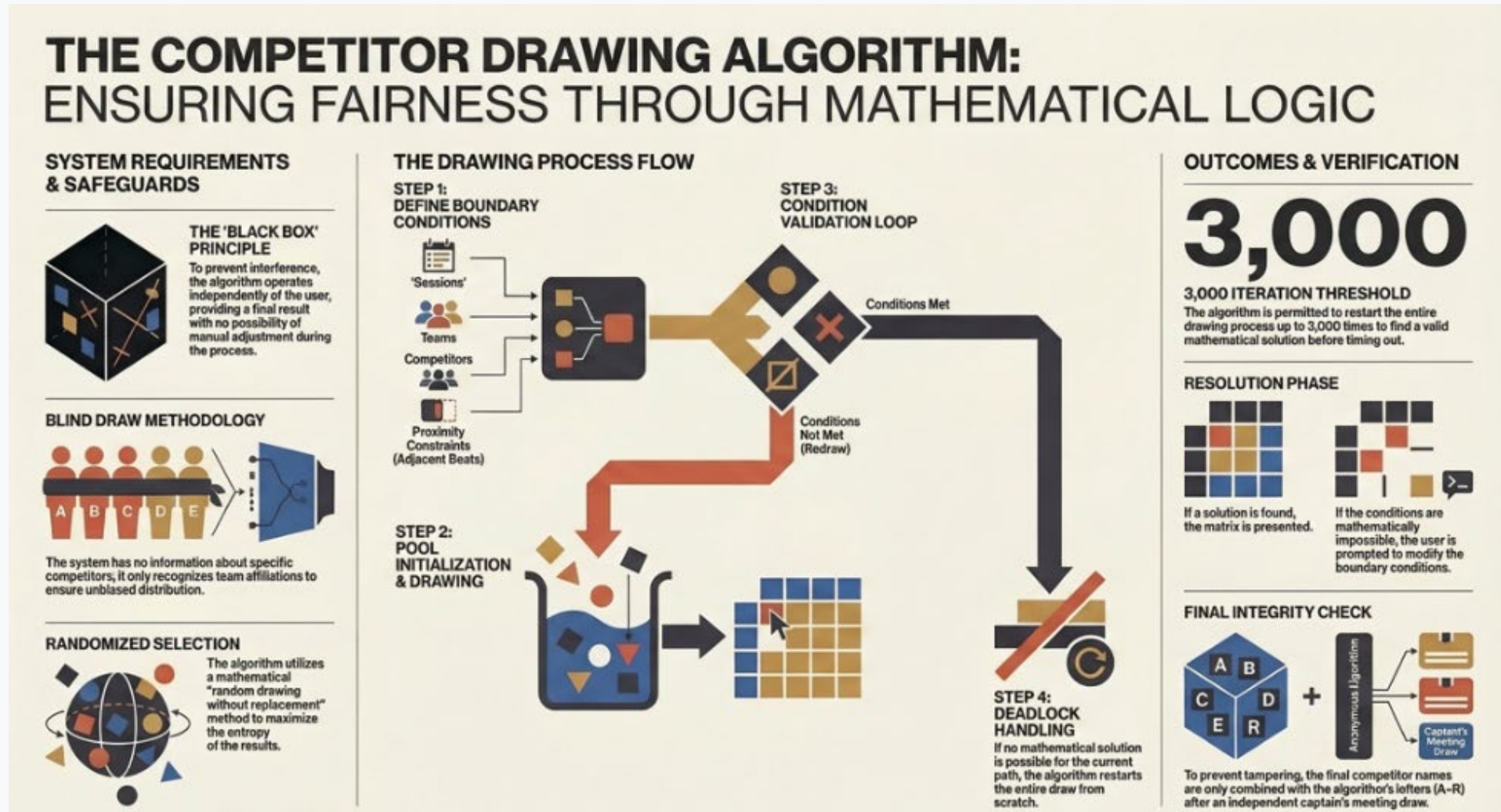
